Pilot Career Tack Training Sequence

(The amount of training time may vary between individuals based upon study, frequency of lessons, and student ability)

1. Private Pilot: 3-6 Months
2. Instrument Pilot: 3-6 Months
3. Commercial Pilot: 6-12 Months (Optional High Performance / Complex Rating)
4. Certified Flight Instructor (CFI): 1-2 Months
5. Certified Flight Instructor Instrument (CFII): 1 Month
6. Multi Engine Instructor (MEI): 1 Month

How to build time:

- Instructing (By far the most common)
- Flying Pipeline
- Flying Skydivers
- Flying banners
- Flying Second in Command
- Splitting/Sharing Time

Pilot Experience Requirements - Charter:

- VFR (Visual Flight Rules) PIC (Pilot in Command) (Alaska)
- 500 Hours
- 100 hours cross country, 25 of which must be at night
- Commercial, Instrument, and type ratings
- Experience in each make and model to be flown

Pilot Experience Requirements - Airlines:

- Pilot must be 23 years of age
- Multi-Engine, instrumen, commercial, type ratings
- ATP 1,500 hours or Restricted ATP (see regulations)
- Within the above total hours, other requirements (see regulations)
- Pass company training, type ratings
